WHY ACM?

Lake Forest College is one of a select number of member schools in the Associated Colleges of the Midwest (ACM) consortium. As a result, choosing an ACM program can offer you several advantages:

- An on-campus faculty advisor for every ACM program.
- Course credits which should easily transfer to your college.
- Ease in the use of Financial Aid for your program.
- No application fee to apply to ACM programs.
- A long history of students from your college attending ACM programs.

CAMPUS APPLICATION PROCEDURES

The application process for off-campus study is done in two stages, beginning the year prior to participation:

Stage 1: Required eligibility forms, available from and returned to the Director of Off-Campus Programs, include:

- An unofficial transcript
- An academic advisor recommendation
- A Dean of Students recommendation
- A financial aid request form
- A Behavior Policy Acknowledgment/Harassment Statement

Stage 2: For students confirmed eligible, forms include:

- Stage 2 Petition (from Director of Off-Campus Programs)
- Student statement of purpose
- ACM program application (from ACM website)

Return all completed forms to the Director of Off-Campus Programs.

CAMPUS DEADLINES

November 15, 2009 - Deadline to submit Stage 1 Lake Forest documents for programs during the 2010-11 academic year.

February 1, 2010 - Deadline to submit Stage 2 documents and completed application for selected programs during the 2010-11 academic year.
