WHY ACM?

Monmouth College is one of a select number of member schools in the Associated Colleges of the Midwest (ACM) consortium. As a result, choosing an ACM program can offer you several advantages:

- An on-campus faculty advisor for every ACM program.
- Course credits which should easily transfer to your college.
- Ease in the use of Financial Aid for your program.
- No application fee to apply to ACM programs.
- A long history of students from your college attending ACM programs.

CAMPUS APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- Students must complete the MC application, available from the coordinator of off-campus study or on the Monmouth website. ACM application forms are available from the program advisor, coordinator of off-campus study, or the ACM website. An application consists of the following items:
 1. Monmouth College application to study off-campus
 2. Dean of Student's Recommendation Form
 3. Application form for the ACM program to which you are applying (including essays and letters of recommendation)
 4. Materials Checklist
- The MC application requires signatures from the applicant, academic advisor, campus program advisor, and a financial aid officer. ACM applications also require the signatures of the academic advisor, academic dean, and dean of students- the applicant should obtain the academic advisor's signature, but not the deans' signatures (these will be obtained after the application has been approved).
- Applicants can expect a decision about their on-campus review within a month of the deadline for receipt of applications.
