WHY ACM?

- Programs that are small in size, with other students from similar colleges.
- Course credits which should easily transfer to your college.
- Ease in the use of Financial Aid, with no ACM program application fee.
- A long history of students from your college attending ACM programs.

CAMPUS APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- Fill out the application for the ACM program in which you are interested. The application can be found on the ACM website or with the campus program advisor. Consult with the campus program advisor or the Office of the Registrar to get more information about programs in which you might be interested.
- Consult with your academic advisor about how study on an off-campus program fits into your academic plans.
- The Office of the Registrar can provide information about how credits and grades will count toward academic requirements and your degree.

CAMPUS DEADLINES

No specific Ripon deadlines- simply follow the ACM application deadlines:

October 15, 2010 - Deadline for Spring 2011 (international programs).

October 31, 2010 - Deadline for Spring 2011 (Chicago Programs).

March 15, 2011 - Deadline for all Summer/Fall 2011 programs.
