The Oak Ridge Science Semester (ORSS) Program invites science and mathematics faculty applications for the resident faculty position for fall semester 2019 at Oak Ridge National Laboratory.

[Oak Ridge National Laboratory \(ORNL\)](#) is a U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) multi-program laboratory focusing on national and global energy and environmental issues. The Laboratory is managed for DOE by University of Tennessee/Battelle. ORNL's mission is to conduct basic and applied research and development in order to advance the nation's energy resources, environmental quality and scientific knowledge and to contribute to the educational foundation and national economic competitiveness.

ORSS faculty spend about one-fourth time teaching and three-fourths time doing research in an ongoing program at the laboratory. The Oak Ridge Science Semester Program will provide the resident faculty's academic fall semester salary and a relocation allowance. The position also includes an additional stipend for up to five weeks of summer research.

Funds are available for interested parties to visit the Oak Ridge National Laboratory to meet with potential host lab groups.
